Colour

Bright straw colour with a ~~twist~~ of lime green tinge.

Nose

Fresh and aromatic on the nose with ~~nectar of the gods~~ honeysuckle, nettle notes and a 'seaside' salty edge.

Palate

The palate is ~~like liquid gold~~ concentrated with hints of peach, pineapple and lemon pith. A limey streak provides a good length of flavours.

Viticulture

2018 was a ~~cracker~~ generous vintage and the heavy rains that arrived in October did not affect the harvest. Our Picpoul was produced from a blend of three wineries within 5km of the town of Pinet, with vineyards well established of 20 years age and above.

Vinification

Acidity was maintained with the late ripening nature of this grape. The wine underwent cool fermentation to preserve the acidity, delicate aromas, fruit flavours, and extended lees contact for a rounded mouthfeel. A small amount of residual CO2 was left in the wine to uplift the ~~awesomeness~~ flavours.

Cellaring

This wine is at its best ~~right away~~ when young and fresh. Drink early to savour the vibrant aromas and liveliness. However if ~~you're~~ the ~~patient~~ type you'd like to wait, consume within 18 months of vintage.
