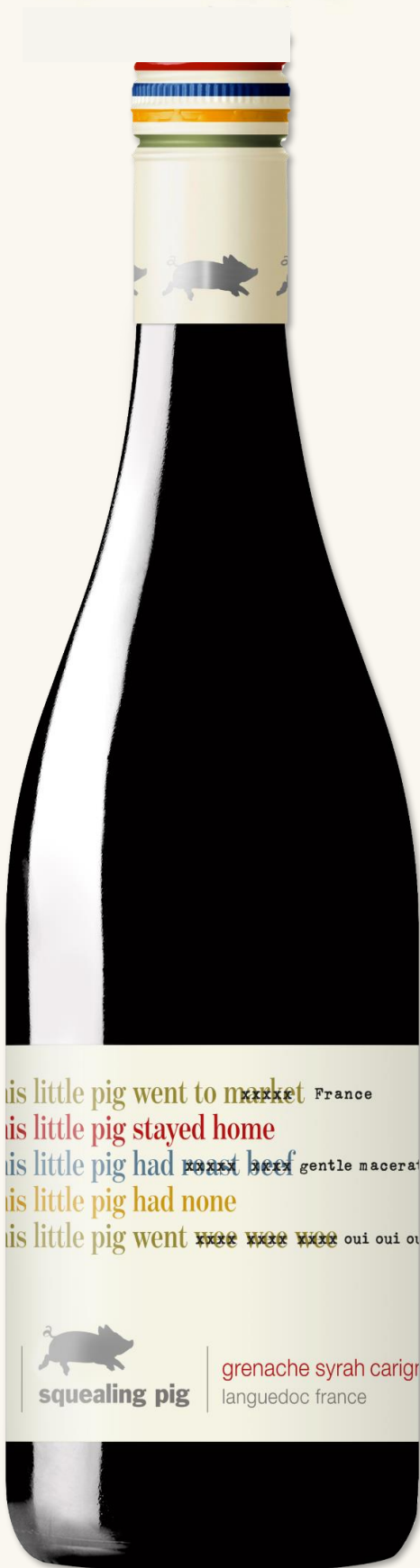

Colour

Deep purple ~~rain~~

Nose

Bursting with black fruits and toasted notes, and a wild 'Garrigue' character from the Languedoc hills.

Palate

The palate is ~~e'est magnifique!~~ rich and complex with a good balance of fruit, spice and hints of truffle.

Viticulture

2017 was a year with frost in spring and a period of drought in summer resulting in an early harvest. Luckily, ~~we love nothing more than a challenge~~ a good selection resulted in a standout wine.

Vinification

The fruit for this ~~oh so yummy I cannot wait to open it~~ blended red wine comes from selected grape parcels of Grenache, Syrah and Carignan had traditional red wine vinification with gentle maceration for between 15-20 days to extract colour, flavour and tannins. To add complexity, each cuvee was in contact with medium toast French oak for up to six months before the final blending.

Cellaring
